SEARCH Study Overview

- **What is the SEARCH Study?**
- SEARCH is a national research project funded by NHS England. It aims to improve early detection of lung cancer in Hodgkin Lymphoma survivors who are at higher risk but often missed by current screening programmes.
- **The study will:**
 - Use a specially adapted risk calculator to better estimate lung cancer risk.
 - Offer screening to eligible survivors through NHS lung health check services.
 - Evaluate how well this approach works and how acceptable it is to patients.
 - Explore and better understand health inequalities and barriers to screening participation.

 - Share your views on the study design and delivery.
 - Help us understand what matters most to patients.
 - Advise on how we communicate with the public and professionals.
